

# Blackjack Tournaments

**Time:** Sunday, 4:00 PM – 7:00 PM

**Cost:**

\$25 buy-in  
7 players per tournament round  
House fee - \$15, Dealer fee - \$10, per round

**Prizes**

1<sup>st</sup> Place - \$125  
2<sup>nd</sup> Place - \$25

**Tournament PROMOTION RULES:**

1. As soon as we get seven players on the tournament list we will start a single table tournament.
2. Each player will receive \$100 in tournament chips.
3. At the end of the tournament, all chips will be counted to determine the first and second place winners.

By participating in any tournament, you agree to abide by the rules and behave in a courteous manner. A violator may be verbally warned, suspended from play for a specified length of time, or disqualified from the tournament. Chips from a disqualified participant will be removed from play.

1. Players will draw for seating positions at the table with an optimum of seven (7) players per table.
2. Each participant will receive an equal amount of non-cash value chips.
3. Each hand will be played as per the approved Blackjack policies and procedures.
4. Each player must wager on every hand dealt.
5. The dealer will select the person who will wager last by dealing a single card for each player at the table. The highest card (in case of a tie - the 1<sup>st</sup> highest card) recipient will receive the 'Dealer' button and will be allowed to wager last.
6. After each hand is played, the dealer button will rotate clockwise (from the dealer's perspective) to the next player and they will be the last to wager.
7. Once any wager is placed in the betting circle it cannot be changed (unless it does not meet the table minimum).
8. All wagers must be placed prior to any cards being dealt.
9. All wagers will be made in a clockwise rotation starting to the right of the dealer button.
10. Each player must play his or her own chips and cards.
11. No tournament entry and/or advancement can or will be awarded to another player - no exceptions.
12. In the event of a 'tie', two or more players with an equal amount of chips, additional hands will be played to determine the advancing player(s).
13. A player must be present at the table to stop the action by calling "time."
14. Only breaks allowed are at the discretion of the tournament director.
15. If two (or more) players go broke during the same hand, the player starting the hand with the larger amount of money finishes in the higher tournament place for prize money and any other award.
16. The number of rounds will be determined by the number of entries. The first round will consist of 7 hands, second round - 10 hands, and third or more rounds - 14 hands (the number of hands may be adjusted by management as determined by participation levels).
17. Management is not required to rule on any private deals, side bets, or redistribution of the prize pool among finalists.
18. Private agreements by remaining players in an event regarding distribution of the prize pool are not condoned. Any private agreement that excludes one or more active competitors is improper by definition. A tournament event is expected to be played until completion. A private agreement that removes all prize money from being at stake in the competition is unethical.
19. Management retains the right to cancel any event, or alter it in a manner fair to the players.
20. Spectators are to remain at least an arm's length distance from the back of the players chair at tables in play.
21. Decision of the tournament director is final.

## General Promotion Rules

1. Must be a Player's Club member to participate in all promotions and claim prizes.
2. Must have a valid ID to claim all prizes.
3. Player's must be 21 or older to participate. Muscogee Casino reserves the right to determine the eligibility of any contestant.
4. A customer's name may be drawn more than once per day for promotions, unless otherwise stated.
5. No employee of the Muscogee Casino, his or her significant other, or any household winner is eligible to participate.
6. By participating, customers allow Muscogee Casino to use their name and likeness for promotional purposes without additional compensation.
7. All decisions made by Muscogee Casino are final and binding.
8. Muscogee Casino reserves the right to change, alter, or cancel the promotion without notification.
9. All prizes are non-transferable, void where prohibited by law. No substitutions for any prizes will be allowed unless authorized by management. In the event a winner chooses not to accept a prize, they forfeit any and all claims to the prize, which then can be awarded to another contestant at the discretion of Muscogee Casino.
10. The use of Muscogee Player's Club Cards by other patrons other than those whose name appears on the card is a violation of our promotional policies.
11. Muscogee Casino is not responsible for lost, damaged, or misplaced entries that prevent reception of your contest entry or attempt to participate.
12. Title 31 regulations apply to all prizes won.
13. Internal Revenue Service regulations apply to all prizes.
14. Any violation of the above contest rules or addendum will constitute disqualification and prizes will not be awarded by Muscogee Casino, their agencies, sponsors, or representatives.
